How to patch t1-11 siding

Some DIY fixes work like a charm. Some don't work at all and you end up making things worse than they started. Others work just long enough for you to get comfortable and forget about them. I'm looking at you old siding patch. You may remember a post from about a year ago when we noticed some holes in our siding and patched 'em up using this badass goopy stuff. If you don't remember, click the link above :) Basically, our T1-11 siding (which is pretty much cardboard) had some weak spots at the bottom where rain had splashed up over the years. We patched it with Ready Patch (the aforementioned badass goop), let it dry, slapped on some paint, and called it good enough! It was pretty awesome for a year... and then the floodgates opened (literally, it flooded like crazy here in Houston) and our patches decided they had taken enough wear and tear. We decided ok... time to suck it up and pay to get this siding replaced. But while talking to the siding guy, he said if we didn't want to replace the whole face of the siding, we could just patch the bottom of it with a protective board. He pointed to the board you see along the bottom of the siding in the photo above. See that? He said that was actually a patch that the previous owner had probably done. Basically, as long as there's no moisture currently trapped, you can just patch over the bad stuff with a new board to protect it! Since we didn't want to pay \$1000 for the whole face of siding to be replaced (after all, the rest of it was in good shape), we decided to try our hand at this new type of patch. First things first, we had to rip off the old board patching the bottom. Evan used a utility knife to score the paint/caulk where the board met the siding. Then he used a tiny crowbar to pry it off. See below! Yep we are incorporating gifs now. But only sometimes. When we remember to :) When Evan pulled off the board, it took off a good chunk of the old siding with it. Lots of damage, but all dry at least! Then it was time to put up the new boards. We needed about 10-1/2 feet of wood, so we picked up two 6-foot pieces of 1"x10" because we couldn't fit a 12-footer in either of our cars. We grabbed some bricks from our garage to support the boards and used a level to make sure everything was aligned correctly. Evan nailed it in and grabbed the second board. Halfway through nailing it in, we started noticing that at least one of these boards was not flat. Or maybe the side of our house was not flat. Either way, it was not good. It may not look like much in the photo, but every time we tried to hammer in whatever part of whatever board was gaping, it would pop out a different corner. With daylight fading, we decided not to waste any more time on dumb non-flat boards. We went back to Home Depot looking for other options. And what we found was even better than our original plan! First off we found this roll of waterproofing tape called Protecto Wrap that's typically used to seal off windows and doors. We decided since our wall isn't totally flat/straight we might end up with gaps even if we buy new boards... so we should seal it with the wrap as extra protection. We scraped off all the loose bits from the old siding before rolling out the wrap. It was definitely easier doing this with two people. Evan held the roll while I pressed it against the house. This stuff was SERIOUS. The adhesive was sorta tar-like and it molded to all the grooves in our siding. The second thing we found at Home Depot was some hardiplank siding we could use instead of regular wood. This was awesome for three reasons- one: it's waterproof, two: it's flexible, and three: it's cheaper! It wouldn't fit in our car so we had to borrow Evan's dad's truck. Worth it though! You can see how flexible it is in the photo below. We cut it down to size with a jigsaw. It was a little tricky to cut because the blade wanted to do its own thing, so Evan used our right angle (and some elbow grease) to keep it in line. It did WAY better than the original wood boards. We did have some trouble finding places nails would stick on the left side (hence the bajillion nails you see in the photo below) but in the end we got it pretty secure. And to be honest, we weren't tooooo worried about it because the real protection was coming from that wrap we used. After securing it, I took over with my handy caulk gun to caulk over the gaps. We went up the sides of the window frames a bit as well where the paint was cracking. OMG IT'S SO BEAUTIFUL That was sarcasm. It was pretty messy. But once we painted over it everything looked great! And now I know gifs make you look like a crazy person. JUST PAINTING HERE I LOVE PAINT WANT SOME PAINT! We are pretty confident about this fix! Guess we'll check in again in a year and let you know how it's holding up! Tagged exterior, siding, wood working Exterior building products include T-111 siding. It's real wood, even though it has layers like plywood. It has vertical lines spaced about 8 inches apart to lend an aesthetic appeal. Equipped with a type of tongue-and-groove edges, the 5/8-by- 48-by-96-inch sheets fit together almost seamlessly. T-111 is used on residential buildings, commercial and outdoor sheds alike. Moisture is the biggest problem with T-111. It typically seeps into open seams and causes rot or decay. It typically appears at the bottom of the sheet but may occur anywhere water gets in. You don't need to replace it in bulk. Splice in a new piece to repair it. Measure the damaged area of the T-111 siding. Use a table saw to cut a piece that's at least 2 inches bigger than the damaged area around the perimeter. The piece should be square or rectangular. Center the piece of T-111 over the damaged area with equal proportions of overhang all the way around. If the damaged area is at the bottom, flush the bottom edge of the new piece with the bottom of the existing damaged siding. Use a straightedge or level to ensure that the new piece is aligned vertically with the old siding. Screw the new piece to the existing siding using a drill/driver and 1-inch screws. Stretch a chalk line around the new piece one side at a time. Snap the chalk line to create a pattern on the existing siding that outlines the patch. Unscrew the new piece of siding and remove it. Apply sealant to all four edges of the new pieces of T-111 siding. Brush the sealant on to saturate all four edges and set it aside to dry. Set the blade of a circular saw to cut 5/8-inch deep. Cut along the chalk lines using the circular saw. Remove the damaged piece. Pry it out with a screwdriver if necessary and remove all the nails using a claw hammer or diagonal pliers. Place the new piece of T-111 siding into the hole. Screw it to the original studs and sheathing where the old piece came out with 2-inch screws, using the original nail or screw hole pattern. Cut the tip from a tube of outdoor silicone sealant with diagonal pliers. Run a heavy bead of silicon around the perimeter or contact area where the splice fits, forcing the sealant as far as possible into the spliced lines. Splice in a new piece to repair it. Measure the damaged area of the T-111 siding. Center the piece of T-111 over the damaged area with equal proportions of overhang all the way around. Screw the new piece to the existing siding using a drill/driver and 1-inch screws. How do you repair vertical wood siding? How to Repair Wood Siding: Replace rotted siding Evaluate the boards. Decide which boards need replacing and where to make your cuts. Cut the nails. Make the first cut with a circular saw. Finish the cut with a sharp utility knife. Pry off the rotted boards. Install the new boards. How do you repair hardboard siding? Sand down the cracked area and apply a flexible, all-purpose exterior vinyl spackling compound, using a putty knife. Smooth the patch before it hardens. Allow it to dry, lightly sand the patched area, and finish it to match your siding. How do you seal the bottom of T1-11 siding? Trim the siding with one-by-four-inch wooden trim, covering the gaps around windows and doors, under the soffit and on the corners of the house. Nail the trim with two-inch galvanized nails, then caulk around it with acrylic latex caulk. Can you patch siding over T1-11? Tom: Yes. If you have a hole or crack too big to fill with caulk, consider patching the area with the same-colored siding. Patching a hole might require more work, but the repair will be well worth it once the eye sore is gone. How do you fix a big hole in vinyl siding? Fix Large Vinyl Siding Hole Obtain a matching piece of siding. Cut the replacement piece larger than the damaged area. Cut off the top nailing strip on replacement piece. Hold the replacement piece over the damage. Permanently attach the new piece over damage with construction adhesive. How do you fill screw holes in wood siding? The type of filler follows the size of the patch. For holes up to and gouges narrower than 1/2 in., use Elmer's interior/exterior Carpenter's Wood Filler. Any holes and gouges larger than 1/2 in. should be filled with an epoxy filler or Bondo. How do you fill holes in exterior wood? Holes in wood trim are best filled with wood filler. Nail holes in exterior surfaces, just as with cracks or gaps, can be dealt with using a good caulking. Take the time before you apply any paint on your next project to fill all of the gaps, cracks, and nail holes. How do you seal gaps in wood siding? Epoxies work well for rotted wood or wood with larger holes, but not for cracked or split wood siding. As the wood siding contracts and expands from moisture give-and-take, the hardened filler will pop out. Flexible caulk is the best product to use on cracked or split siding, but not just any caulk will work. What can I use instead of T1-11 siding? LP SmartSide is an engineered wood product that is more weather-resistant than T1-11 siding. It is less susceptible to rot, fungal decay, insect damage and thus requires less maintenance. LP SmartSide is, overall, a better cladding solution for most people. How do you repair Masonite hardboard siding? How to Repair Masonite Wood Siding Scrape off flaking paint and debris from the damaged area using a paint scraper. Hammer down loose nails. Scoop a golf-ball sized amount of elastomeric compound out of the container with a 3-inch trowel. Repeat applying the compound to the area if you can still see a recess. How do you fix a hole in Hardie board siding? Sand over the damaged area lightly but thoroughly with a medium-grit sandpaper to smooth any jagged edges and create an easy grip surface for the patch product. Apply the patch product to the damaged area with the flexible putty knife to fill in any indentations or holes. How do you repair particle board siding? Left unpainted, pressboard siding can be damaged severely by moisture. Apply exterior wood putty to the defect with a putty knife. Consult the manufacturer's instructions regarding putty drying time. Sand the repair with 120-grit sandpaper. Paint the repair with exterior-grade house paint. Do you caulk between T1-11 siding? The top T-111 panel should be installed about 1/4 inch off the shelf formed by the flashing to prevent moisture from wicking up into the wood. This is especially important when using engineered siding. If the siding was installed with Z-flashing, do not caulk in the grooves. Does T1-11 need to be sealed? It is sometimes called T1-11. Plywood should be treated or primed before installation to ensure it is completely protected from the elements. Sealing the material is a fairly straightforward job if the siding you purchase is not green. Do you have to seal T1-11 siding? To prevent water damage with any siding it requires proper installation, sealing, and maintenance. OSB T1-11 siding has more issues with water because of how it is manufactured. If you simply have a small puncture in your vinyl siding, repair is easy. Use siding cleaner to clean the area around the puncture. Wipe the area dry with a rag. Cut the tip of your color-match vinyl siding caulk and fit the tube into your caulk gun. Squeeze the caulk into the puncture to fill the space behind the hole. How do you seal pipe holes in siding? Spread silicone on all four sides of the hole and at the slit at the bottom to completely seal the edges (Photo 3). You may need to tape the rubber to the siding temporarily until the caulk dries. Let the caulk dry overnight, then partially fill the boot with foam; seal the hole from the inside as well. How do you fix a big hole in vinyl siding? If you take your time, you will get completely smooth surface where you once had a large gap. Step 1 - Prep the surface. The first stage of any decorating project is preparation. Step 2 - Applying the wood filler. Step 3 - Allow the wood filler to dry. Step 4 - Sand the filler down. Step 5 - Apply your wood finish. What can I use to patch exterior wood? Epoxy is the perfect material to make permanent repairs of rotting window sills, door jambs and exterior molding that are difficult to remove and expensive to replace. Epoxy is easy to handle too. You mix it like cookie dough, mold it like modeling clay and, when it hardens, you carve and sand it just like wood. What happens when Masonite gets wet? Masonite composite hardboard has a natural moisture resistance. Moisture causes the area around the penetration to expand. This expansion causes the fibers around the penetration to loosen, weakening the Masonite. Can you patch hardboard siding? Repairing Hardboard Siding Immediately fill holes with a flexible, all-purpose filler such as pre-mixed bridging and patching compound, following label directions. Sand the area smooth, and then paint it to match the rest of the siding. Do you need plywood under T1-11 siding? It is best to check the local building code to determine if plywood sheathing is required. Even though it may not be considered necessary, many builders feel it is best to use plywood under T1 siding if the structure will be used for human habitation. How much is a sheet of t111? T1-11 Plywood Costs Depending on the finish and size, this siding costs between \$25 and \$40 per 4 foot by 8 foot sheet. Add installation costs and construction materials, and you end up with a range between \$3.50 and \$7.20 per square foot. Is it better to paint or stain T 111 siding? Plywood T1-11 accepts stain well and takes on a grainy appearance that blends well in rural surroundings. Staining T1-11 is less work than painting it — you may need only one coat — but prior cleaning of the substrate is even more important, because any dirt and discoloration shows through. Can You Use Flex Seal on vinyl siding? Flex Seal can be used on almost every surface: wood, metal, tile, concrete, masonry, fabric, glass, plastic, aluminum, porcelain, drywall, rubber, cement, and vinyl. Plus, it won't sag or drip in the summer heat, and it won't crack or peel in the winter cold. It even prevents corrosion. How do you fix gaps in siding? How to Close a Gap in Vinyl Siding Step 1: Step away from the caulk gun. If the hole is more than a 1/4 of an inch, caulk won't solve the problem. Step 2: Head to the hardware store. To slide two pieces back together, you'll need a zip tool. Step 3: Unlock the overlapping pieces. Step 4: Secure your siding. How do you seal under siding?
